The following is the agreed report of the Board of Management following a meeting on 25 February 2026.

- The following reports were presented to the board:
 - A Child Protection Oversight Report
 - A Treasurer's Report
 - A Principal's Report
 - An Anti-bullying Report
- The Board conducted its annual review of the Child Safeguarding Policy and thanks parents who provided feedback as part of the review. The policy and notice of annual review will be circulated and published on the school website.
- The Board has signed the funding agreement for the CLÁR Programme. A project team will support the Board with this project. We will be seeking tenders for the project in the coming weeks.
- The board approved a staff meeting for Thursday, 12 March. The school will close early to facilitate the meeting and further details will be communicated through Aladdin.
- An Oide Facilitator will visit the school on Tuesday, 10 March to support staff professional development in Mathematics.
- Seachtain na Gaeilge will take place from 9–13 March. The week will conclude with an assembly during Lá Glas, a non-uniform day on Friday, 13 March.
- A Book Fair will take place from 11–20 March. Further details will issue via Aladdin.
- The board notes the publication of the Standardised School Year Circular. The school calendar for 2026.2027 is being finalised and will issue to parents shortly through Aladdin.
- The Board will be carrying out maintenance works in the car park over the coming weeks.
- The Board welcomes the Department's decision to pause the outcome of SNA reviews. As a result, the school's SNA allocation will remain unchanged for the 2026/2027 school year. At the time the pause was announced, the outcome of our review had not yet been received.
- The Board wishes Sixth Class pupils and their families an enjoyable Confirmation Day on Saturday, 21 March. The Board also extends its good wishes to pupils in Second Class who will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Thursday, 26 March.
- Sixth Class will graduate from the school on Wednesday 17 June.
- A modified Incidental Irish Inspection took place in the school on Monday, 9 February. The visit formed part of a wider Inspectorate research project being conducted in schools.
- The school will close on Monday 16 and 17 March. There will be a half day closure for Easter on Friday 27 March.
- The next meeting of the board will take place in April.
