During the season of autumn, we spent time outside looking and investigating for signs of autumn in our school. As the pictures show, the children really enjoyed this activity.

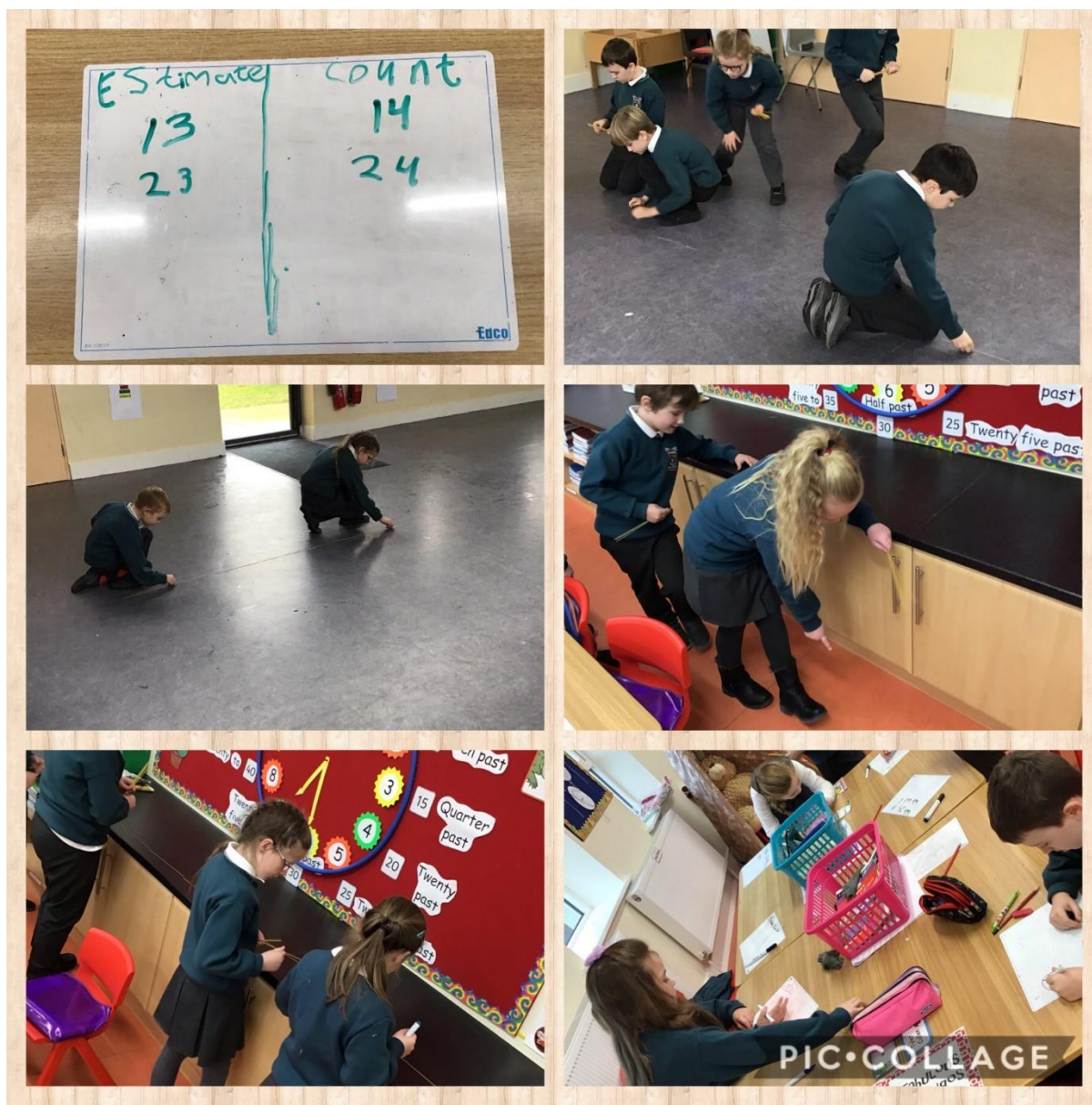






Maths
