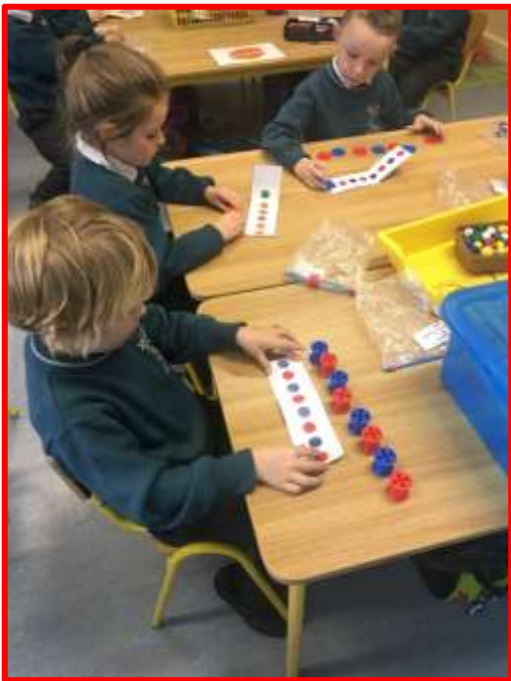


Senior Infant News – October 2018.
